


Bygone Beautys Treasured Teapot Museum & Tearooms would like to welcome you and your guests on a visit to the Greater Blue Mountains World Heritage Area and our very own unique attraction. The following information outlines the details of our facilities and menu options for group bookings. Bygone Beautys is conveniently located within walking distance of other attractions and things to see and do.

Bygone Beautys is nestled in the picturesque mountain village of Leura and houses the world's largest private collection of teawares. There are more than 5,500 teapots in the collection, spanning five centuries and including teapots from all over the world, most of which were collected within Australia.

The Treasured Teapot Museum reflects and preserves the diversity of Australian tea-drinking culture. Everywhere you look you will see teapots; old and new, rare and collectable originating from Australia, America, Asia, Africa and Europe. The collection features teapots made from different materials including china, silver, silver plate, pottery, fine porcelain, cast iron, bakelite, decoupage and textiles.

Major extensions and renovations were officially opened at a glittering soiree by former NSW Governor Professor the Honourable Dame Marie Bashir AD CVO on August 4 2015. The revamp includes a new museum space featuring the teapot collection and an array of tea-related artefacts, a function room, formal tearoom and retail area specialising in all things tea-related. There is also lift access from the 24-space carpark.

To make your guests' day complete, morning tea, lunch or afternoon tea is available in our Tearooms. Groups of 20 or more guests will also enjoy an informative, witty and thoroughly entertaining teapot talk.

Bygone Beautys has featured on ABC's *Collectors*, *Getaway* and *Sydney Weekender* as a "must see" attraction when visiting the Blue Mountains. Other notable appearances include *Sydney Escapades*, *Sydney Secrets*, *Fresh* and *Sydney Weekender Magazine*.

In 2011, Bygone Beautys went into the Blue Mountains Business Awards Hall of Fame, after winning the People's Choice Award for three consecutive years.
